- Final status will be presented to ATSRAC at the October meeting

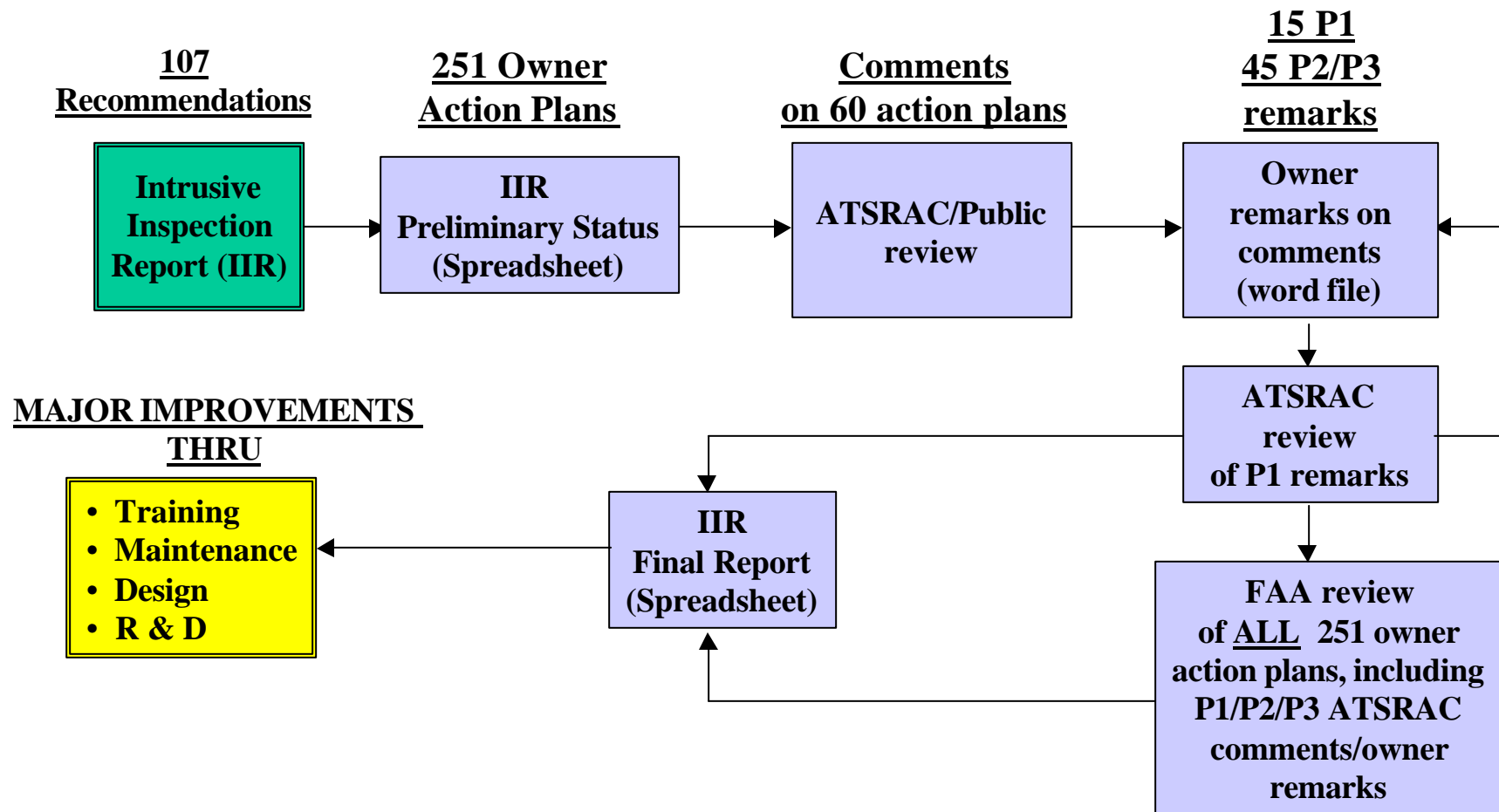
