Renewal of the following training material for 8 hours of Inspection Authorization (IA) training has been reviewed. As of this date, the material submitted meets the requirements of Federal Aviation Regulation (FAR) Section 65.93(a)(4) for Inspection Authorization Renewal and is approved under the following course numbers:

#AGL/0903/0002/8 "Aircraft Wiring Practices" (8 hrs)

The original or a copy of this letter of acceptance shall be available at each refresher training session presented. A copy of the refresher training material that was accepted will be kept on file for future reference for a minimum of two years following the date of acceptance. You may provide this accepted training at any location. You shall, however, notify the local FSDO/IFO in writing with where and the date the course was approved 30 days prior to offering the refresher training.

Documentation for each person attending this training will consist of a certificate of training or similar document showing the name of the training, course number, date of attendance, length of training, and the instructor's name and affiliation.

You will be required to maintain a list of attendees for a period of not less than two years. This list will be made available to any FAA office upon request.

Flight Standards Airworthiness Inspectors shall be admitted to any session being presented under this letter of acceptance. In addition, you shall provide a copy of any materials that the normal attendees of the refresher training would receive.

You are encouraged to allow the local FSDO/IFO an opportunity to present information and materials to the attendees where the refresher training is given. Local FSDO/IFO's are encouraged to attend all IA refresher training in their district.

You will be expected to comply with the guidance contained in the Airworthiness Inspectors Handbook (FAA Order 8300.10) and FAA Order 8470.1D in order for this letter to be effective.

This letter is FAA acceptance of the submitted refresher training in accordance with FAA Order 8470.1D. This acceptance will expire September 4, 2005 (two years) unless changes are made to the program. Any changes to the courses or new courses would require review and acceptance prior to accomplishing the training.
